The dotted lines represent part of a draught of a tract of land surveyed for the Honorable Proprietary's on the 25th day of August 1762 on their warrant dated the 10th day of October 1760. The proprietories appear to have abandoned their claim to this part of their survey as the land is held by persons claiming under Alexander METOGLAN. The Proprietary survey interferes two hundred and sixty seven acres with the Alexander METOGLAN tract.
