



Draught of a tract of land situate in Fannet Township Franklin County containing fifty three acres one hundred & fifty six perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c surveyed 24 October 1829, in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under Proprietary rights &c And by virtue of an order of survey dated 12 May 1768. No 4975 granted James Elliott for 50 acres joining his other land and the Round Top Mountain.

Report.

The above tract is wholly included within the lines of a tract of 151 acres resurveyed in 1784 on a warrant to William Elliott for 100 acres dated the 17th June 1763, and held under said title.

Note.

The survey on Wm Elliotts warrant first made extending Southward to dotted line marked A & northward only to the line marked B upon a resurvey in 1784 the boundary was extended Northward to the line C & making the Creek the boundary Southward; thus augmenting the survey to 151 acres & apparently embracing the land intended for the location of James Elliott above mentioned.
