


FORM NO 1.



Situate on Laurel Run Barree township Huntingdon County containing two hundred and twenty nine acres and allowance of six per cent surveyed the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1775 for Martin Lauman on warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1774.

The dotted lines represent part of a survey made for Samuel Bell, on warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 1774. This survey interferes one hundred and twenty nine acres with the Martin Lauman tract. Samuel Bell, conveyed to David Gibbons, who conveyed to Samuel Porter, who conveyed to James Ingraham the present owner.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of December 1908
