



A draft of a tract of land situate below the forks on Big Conolaway Creek in Bethel township Bedford County, containing fifty one acres and ninety three perches and allowance of six per cent for roads & 50 surveyed for John Lynn the 20th day of November 1828 on warrant dated the 8th day of September 1755.

To Gabriel Heister, Esq. S. B. James O'Connor, D. S. M. B. The dotted and black lines represent the draft of a tract of land surveyed for Elisha Linn on warrant dated the 16th day of February 1789. This tract interferes fifty one acres and ninety three perches with the John Lynn survey. John Lynn devised this tract to Addis Linn who obtained the aforesaid warrant and then devised the same to Elisha Linn whose heirs now own the land.
