This tract interferes Two Hundred and twenty two acres and seventy perches with the Obidiah Truax survey. Obidiah Truax devised the above tract to his heirs who conveyed to ~~Abner~~ ^{Jacob} Hart, who obtained the aforesaid warrant, and devised the same to Abner Hart the present owner.
