 Adam Hummel, or 68. A Warrant was afterwards granted to Nicho-
 who resides on it. laus Hittle dated the 16th November 1784. which was
 afterwards by Virtue of an order from the Board of
 Property dated the 7th day of November 1791—executed
 & laid on the above tract.—and I believe Patented. The
 improvement on this tract was begun sometime prior
 to the date of Detweillers Appliⁿ but I cannot ascertain
 how long before —
