



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 28th Sept: 1752. to James Gillaspay for 50 as including an Imp^t bought of Rob^t M^cCormick, joining Thomas Ryley & one Rogers on Conewago Creek, on Lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram — Witness my hand —
