



Warrant dated 15<sup>th</sup> June 1773 to John Graybill for 10<sup>as</sup> Join<sup>g</sup> his other Land, John Abbott & Lawrence Peckinger in Berwick Towne

The whole of the above Tract is an Interference of a Tract of 42<sup>as</sup> 57<sup>p</sup> and all<sup>ce</sup> surveyed originally to William Scott for 30<sup>as</sup> dated 26<sup>th</sup> March 1773 & resurveyed on order. of resurvey to Frederick Baugher dated No<sup>r</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> 1811— situate in Berwick Township Adams County owned by the heirs of Frederick Baugher Dec<sup>d</sup> October 19<sup>th</sup> 1838.
