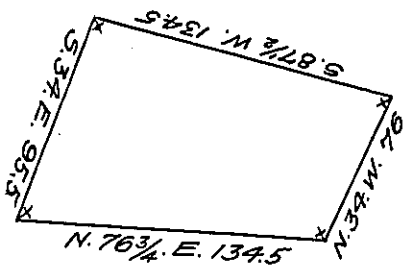

Warrant 23^d March 1756 — to Jacob Giles for 50^{acs}
on Conewago Near the Pidgeon Hills —

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located and Surveyed Warrant 23^d March 1756 to Jacob Giles for 50 acres on Lands situate in Manheim Township, near the Pidgeon hills, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram — Witness my hand —
November 29th 1837. Jno. L. Gubernator —

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of November 1908.
