



Situate in Point Township Northumberland County including his impr. t  
 on the E. Side of the W. branch of Susquehanna about 2 1/2 miles above fort  
 Augusta Surveyed the 15th day of October 1835 by Virtue of an Order N<sup>o</sup> 1921  
 dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1769 granted to William Walker. Containing two  
 hundred & ten acres & twenty four perches, and the usual allowance of  
 Six Per Cent &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed the - day of - for John Musser  
 in pursuance of his order N<sup>o</sup> 3741 dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1769 and  
 is now owned and occupied by John Frick in right of said John Musser.
