Note The same tract of land was surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1769 for Alexander Craig in pursuance of his order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 236 and now owned & occupied by John McPherson in right of the said Alexander Craig.
