



Situate in Point Township Northumberland County on the west side of the N.E. branch of Susquehanna near the point of the forks Joining a 500 acre tract ordered to be Surveyed for the Proprietors extending up & near said branch about a mile Surveyed the 13th day of October 1835 by virtue of an order N^o 1958 dated the 3rd day of April 1769 granted to Philip Dean Containing three hundred and thirty acres & the usual allowance of Six Per Cent.

Note the same tract of land was Surveyed the — day of — for Sarah Lowden in pursuance of her Order dated the 5th day of July 1769 N^o 3614 and is now owned & occupied by various persons as out lots near the Town of Northumberland in Right of said Sarah Lowden.
