



Situate in Kelly township Union (late Berks.) County Surveyed the 4th day of March 1833 by virtue of an order granted to James Warren dated the 3d day of April 1769 No 129 Containing two hundred and eighty Seven Acres and eighty perches with the Usual Allowance &c. Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 17th day of March 1769 for Captn. Kerns being the Allotment which fell to him in the Division of a tract of 1105 Acres Surveyed for the Officers of Col. Turbut Frances Corps in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 9th. day of March 1769 And now owned & Occupied by Thomas Howard & others in right of the said Capn. Kerns.
