



The above described tract of land was surveyed to Charles Campbell on the _____ day of _____ By _____ of the _____ This tract lies upon the land called _____ for by the Location of James Armstrong Junr. upon which I have made a survey on Armstrongs Location on the 8 day of May 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. After making Armstrongs survey upon the above tract, I found among some old field notes the following, which shows I have not been far wrong in the Location of it, "Ja^s. Armstrong lies on a place surv^d. to Charles Campbell on Blacklegs creek above and adjoining Blacklegs Town, Tho^s Campbell adjoining the above tract survey^d. to Ja^s Armstrong."

It would appear from the above that James Armstrong Junr. had been laid upon Thomas Campbells tract but finding that Tho^s Campbells tract was patented on his own title I deemed it unnecessary to change the Location I had made of Armstrongs title - The above tract is owned and occupied Major James Speer who claims under the title to Charles Campbell consequently there is no one claiming under Armstrongs title.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Eighteenth day of September 1908.
