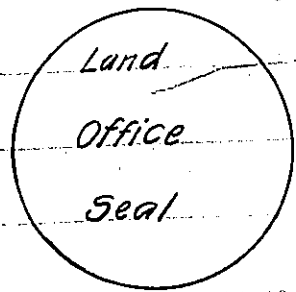


By virtue of a warrant from the proprietaries dated the
