



Situate in Shrewsbury township in the County of York containing as above set forth 56<sup>as</sup> 130 perches and the usual allowance &c. Located on the 4 day of October 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to David Shaffer for 50<sup>as</sup> dated the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 1762 and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report This is wholly the same Land as that surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> of September 1769 by W<sup>m</sup> Mathews on the Application of William Spittler for Valentine Hamspoker No 5062 dated 22<sup>d</sup> June 1768 now owned & occupied by Jacob & Philip Hildebrand. David Shaffer was never in possession of this Land
