


FORM NO. 1.



The whole of the above tract is an interference of a Tract of 261 ac & allce surveyed under Warrant dated 26th March 1760 to Joseph McKinney who sold to George Stevenson, who sold to Thomas Armor, who on the 25th day of February A.D. 1772 (on account of the above survey interfering with Lands patented under Maryland) obtained an order of resurvey and eventually obtained a Patent under T. & R. Penn for said tract of 261 ac. dated 3^d July 1772 - And Thomas Armor conveyed the same to Jacob Kagy & others who now own and possess the same - Situate now in Conowago Township
