



Warr^t 22^d April 1768 to James Twineham to resurvey a Patented Tract &c. & for adding thereto Warr^t 1st May 1767 for 50 acres &c. - In Reading Town^{sh} Interference.

The above Tract was resurveyed Sept. 28th 1813 on the above Warr^t of resurvey - A. & B. are the Parts Patented - C. & D. are vacancies added thereto in pursuance of the warrant of resurvey - C. & D. were patented to Jacob & Henry Albert 17th October 1828 - and now owned by them -
