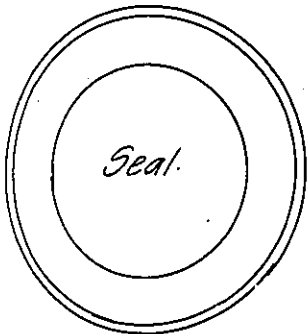


Pennsylvania <sup>obl.</sup>

By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of James Chevers of the County of Chester that we would grant him to take up fifty acres of Land formerly included in the Proprietors Manor of Rockland in Newcastle County, but since left out of the same and included in Concord in Chester County, for which he hath agreed to pay to the Proprietor's Use fifteen pounds within three months after the date hereof ~~these~~ and ye usual Quitrent of Lands in the Province. These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said James Chevers the said quantity of fifty acres of Vacant Land in ye place aforesaid as regularly as the same can be laid out and make Return thereof into the Secretaries Office. Which Survey in case the sd James comply with the Agreement aforesd shall be valid otherwise the same shall be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the second day of November A.D. 1713
