I do hereby Certifie that pursuant to a warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the Seal of the Province to Isaac Taylor directed bearing date the 22^d of the 10th month 1701. The said Isaac Taylor hath made return into the Gene! Surveyor's Office of the Survey of a piece of Land Survey'd to James Chivers the 23 day of December 1701 which being examined and Revised in the said Office is as followeth Viz V. Situate in the Manner of Rocklands in the County of Chester beginning at a hickory tree standing in the line of Concord Township from thence extending North 24 degrees westerly in the said line ninety five perches to a corner black oak thence north eighty one degrees westerly in the line of Birmingham Township two hundred thirty nine perches to a white oak thence south south east two hundred and twenty perches by Edward Wilbourns Land to a Corner Post from thence east north east in the Widow Budds line two hundred and six perches to the first mentioned hickory tree. Containing two hundred acres.
