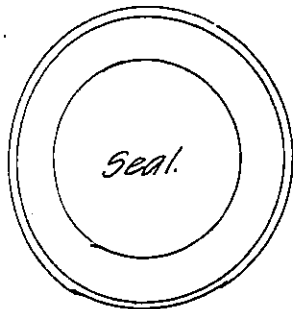


Pensylvania p.

At the Request of Hubert Cassel that we would grant him to take up  
& fifty  
two hundred <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Acres of Land on y<sup>e</sup> West side of Skuylkill near that Tract which  
was Seated by Peter Bizaillon & for some time possessed by Matthew Brooks  
for which he agrees to pay forty pounds for y<sup>e</sup> whole in one year after the date  
hereof with six months Interest for y<sup>e</sup> same. and the yearly Quitrent of one  
Shilling Sterling p. hundred forever. These are to Authorize and Require thee  
to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said Hubert Cassel according to the  
Method of Townships the said quantity of two hundred and fifty Acres of  
Vacant Land in the place afores<sup>d</sup> and make return thereof into the Secre-  
taries Office With which Agreem<sup>t</sup> if the said Hubert shall duly comply thy  
said Survey shall be valid otherwise the same to be void as if it had never  
been made nor this Warr<sup>t</sup> ever Granted. Given under our hands and Seal  
of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> month A.D. 1717
