Lay'd out for Edward Cartledg 150 Acres of Land Laying upon the west side of darbey Creek beginning at a marked white oke standing by darbey Creek being the Corner tree of thomas whidbey thence W~~S~~W into ye woods to a marked Chesnut then NNW 36 Perches to a marked Red oke then N 4 E 20 Perches to a black oke from thence E.N.E. by a line of marked Red trees to a Red oke standing by darbey creek and downe the Creek to the first marked tree.
