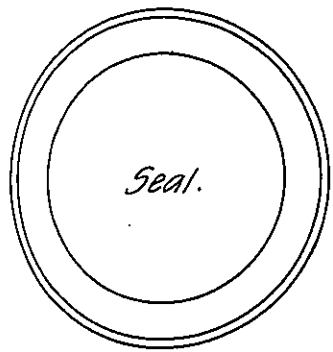


Pensylvania



By the Commission<sup>rs</sup> of Property

At y<sup>e</sup> Request of Thomas Chandler of y<sup>e</sup> County of Chester y<sup>t</sup> we would grant him to take up a certain tract of Land lying on Brandywine Creek formerly laid out to Isaac Helme Jun<sup>r</sup> for 174 acres but afterwards by him thrown up and deserted for 50 acres of w<sup>ch</sup> he has agreed to pay to y<sup>e</sup> Propriet<sup>rs</sup> use twelve pounds ten shilling w<sup>th</sup> in three mo<sup>s</sup> after y<sup>e</sup> date hereof & half a Bushell of wheat yearly forever and for y<sup>e</sup> Rem<sup>dr</sup> y<sup>e</sup> yearly Rent of three bushells of wheat forever. These are to authorize thee to Survey or Cause to be Surveyed to y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Chandler y<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Tract of Land according to y<sup>e</sup> ancient bounds by w<sup>ch</sup> it was at first laid out and make Returns thereof into y<sup>e</sup> Secretarys office w<sup>ch</sup> survey in case y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Thomas shall comply w<sup>th</sup> y<sup>e</sup> said agreem<sup>t</sup> shall be valid otherwise it shall be void & of no effect as if y<sup>e</sup> same had never been made nor this warrant never granted. Given und<sup>r</sup> our hands & Seals of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Province at Philad<sup>a</sup> y<sup>e</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> day of y<sup>e</sup> first month in y<sup>e</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> year of y<sup>e</sup> Reign of Queen Anne over Great Brit-  
ain & <sup>Edw<sup>d</sup> Shippen</sup> Annog. Dom 170<sup>8</sup>  
To Jacob Taylor Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> Griffith Owen  
Isaac Taylor Thy brother being out of town I desire thee J. Logan  
to execute this Warr<sup>t</sup>.
