



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or Other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 30<sup>th</sup> April 1750 - to William Trent for 300<sup>as</sup> on the Chesnut hill &c. near the line of Cumberland as above specified on Lands situate as aforesaid and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
