



Warrant granted 12th April 1771 to Francis Innis for 50^{as} on the West branch of Great Conowago—in the South Mountain in Menallen Town^p.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes I have this day located & surveyed Warrant granted 12th April 1771 to Francis Innis for 50^{as} on the West Branch of Great Conowago—in the South Mountain on Lands situate as aforesaid and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram
