



Warr<sup>t</sup> granted 12<sup>th</sup> April 1771 to Francis Innis for 50<sup>as</sup> on the West branch of Great Conowago in the South Mountain in Meriallem (now Franklin) Town<sup>P</sup>.

The whole of the above Tract is an Interference of a tract of 65<sup>as</sup> 22<sup>ps</sup> & all<sup>ce</sup> surveyed on warrant for 60<sup>as</sup> granted to George Sheffer dated 3<sup>d</sup> December 1771 - Situate in Franklin Town<sup>P</sup> Adams County now owned by John Sterner Witness my hand  
 October 11<sup>th</sup> 1838.
