



A draught of a Survey situate on the South fork of Ten Mile Creek formerly Washington but now Greene County called "Panthers Retreat" containing 406 acres of land and the allowance of 6 P. Cent. for Roads &c. surveyed Novr. 6th 1798 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Sharp for 400 acres dated the 9th December, 1796.
