



Warrant granted 2<sup>d</sup> March 1772 to James Semple for 100<sup>ac</sup> Join<sup>g</sup> & Westward of Gabriel Fickle's & the North side of Robert Moorhead's Land in the South Mountain in Huntingdon Town<sup>sh</sup>.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 2<sup>d</sup> March 1772 to James Semple for 100<sup>ac</sup> as above in Huntingdon Township on Lands situate as aforesaid and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram - Witness my hand
