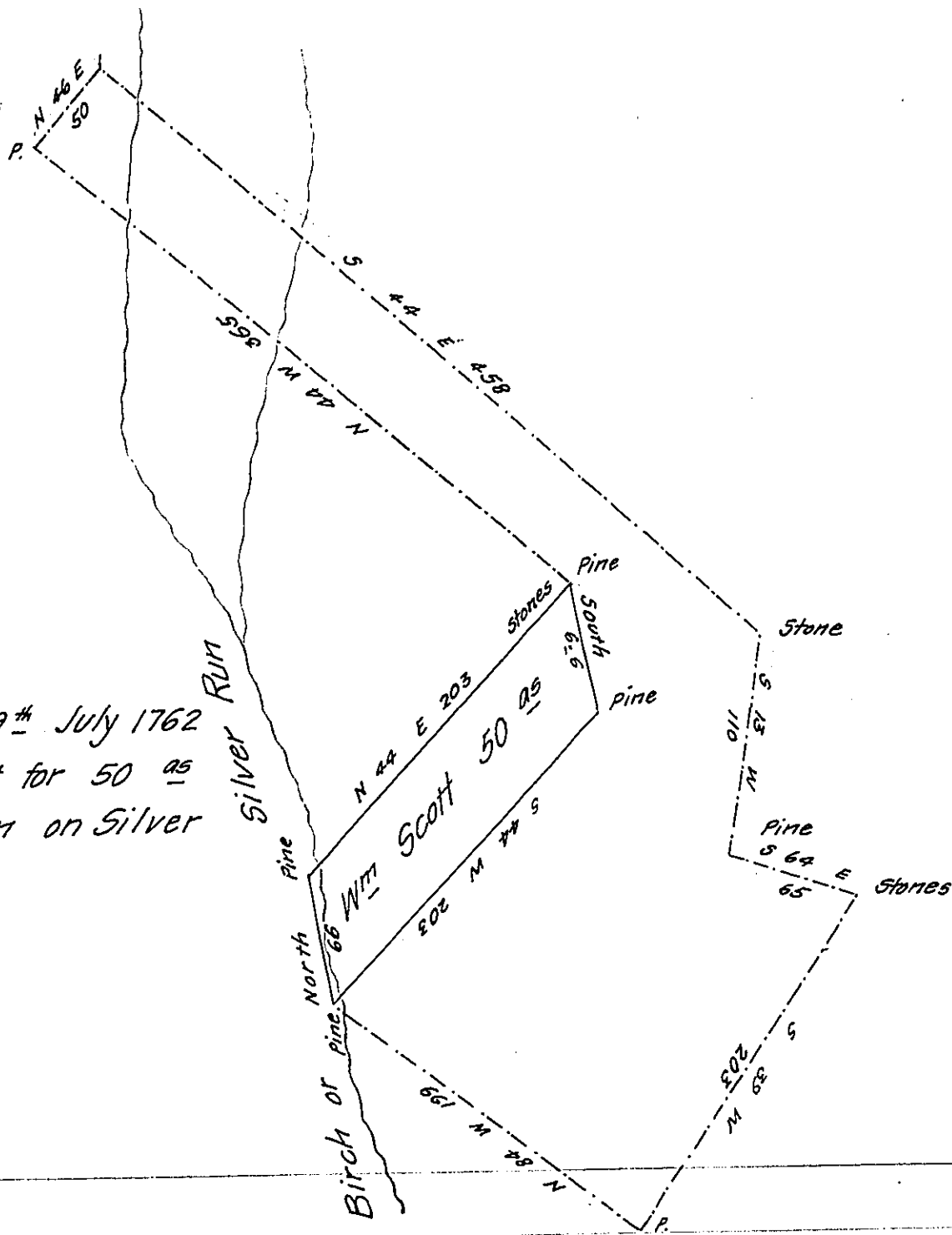


FORM NO 1.

Warrant dated 19th July 1762 to William Scott for 50 ^{as} on the Mountain on Silver Run.



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal & interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 19th July 1762 to William Scott for 50 ^{as} on the Mountain on Silver Run on Lands situate as aforesaid and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram - Witness my hand

October 11th 1838 Jno L. Gubernator -

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty ninth day of October 1908
