



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 10<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1749 to George Shade for 50<sup>ac</sup> in Huntington Township (now Reading & Latimore) Adams County on Lands situate as aforesaid and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
