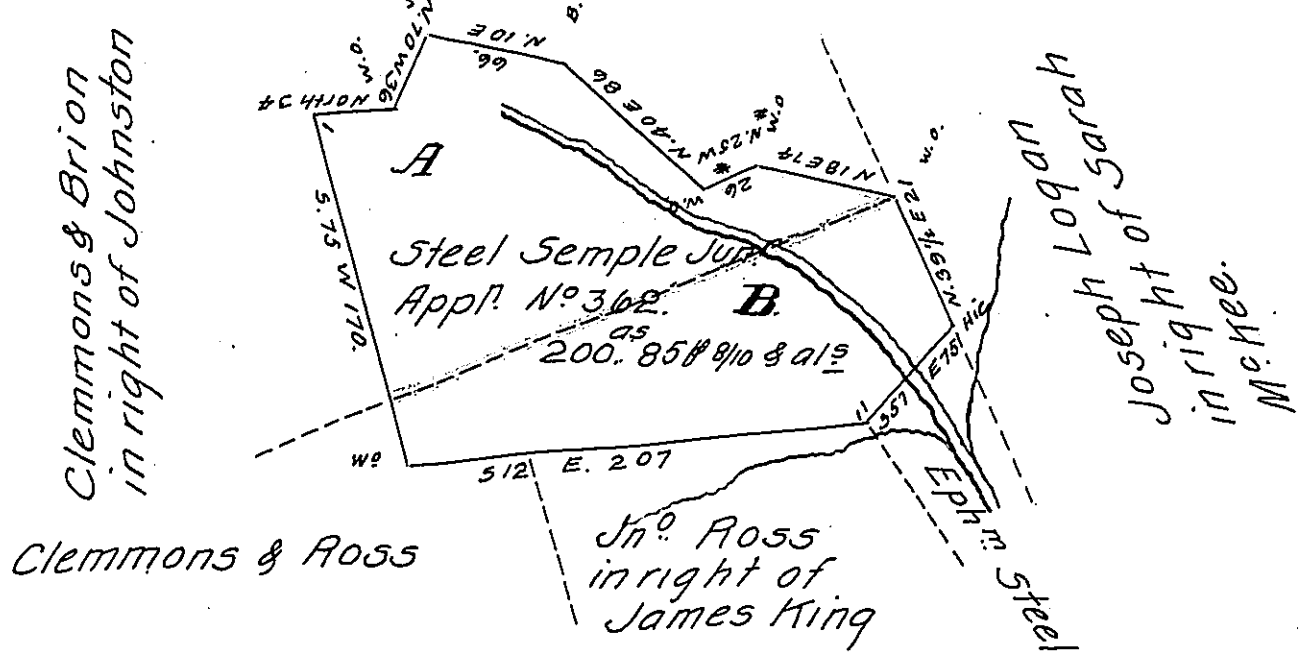

Convenient to the Head Springs of 5<sup>d</sup> branch.
