And by virtue of a Warrant dated 4th April 1744 Granted to Samuel Jones for 188 Acres on Conodoguennet Creek.

Report. The above Survey is included with the lines of a Tract of 217 1/2 Acres Surveyed 6 May 1785 on Warrant to ~~John~~ Thomas McComb dated 21 April 1785. The Survey on McCombs Warrant includes the dotted figures marked A & B. No evidence of Jones Warrant being executed on the Land; But the Land being recognized by the adjoiners as the Land of Samuel Jones at an early day together with the Location on Conodoguennet Creek raises the presumption that the above was the Land intended for said Warrant.
