



Situate in White Deer township Union (late Northumberland) County. Surveyed the 2^d day of November A.D. 1833, by virtue of a Warrant granted to Thomas Graham dated the 23^d day of ^{Jan.} ~~July~~ A.D. 1775. Containing twenty three Acres & Ninety one perches with the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Cent &c.

Note. The same being parts of two tracts of land viz. One thereof Surveyed the 16th day of August 1796 for James McLanahan in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 28th day of November 1774. Containing 206³/₄ Acres &c. as Designated by the Red lines on the above Diagram. And now in the possession & owned by Andrew McLanahan in right of the said James McLanahan, Interference Contains 12 Acres & 121 perches &c. The other thereof Surveyed the 6th day of August 1805 for James McLanahan in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 14th day of March 1775. Containing 30 acres & thirty one perches &c. Designated by the Yellow lines on the above Diagram. Interference Contains 10 Acres & 139¹/₂. And now Owned & Occupied by Andrew McLanahan in right of the said James McLanahan.
