



Situate in (Turbut now) Point Township Northumberland County. on the waters of McCullys Run, above & adjoining land granted to said Robert McCully for which there was an adverse claim. the name I am not in possession of, but am satisfied that Jno Geo. Snaff is located on the ground for which it was intended for. Surveyed on the 19th day of October 1835 by virtue of a Warrant dated the 3rd day of May 1774. granted to Jno Geo. Snaff. Containing two hundred & ninety seven Acres & one half ^{Acres} with the usual allowance of Six Per Cent & c.

Note. The sam- Survey interferes with a Survey in the name of Jas Wilson as represented by the dotted lines which Survey was made for said Wilson by virtue of his Order dated the 5th Sep^r 1769. N^o 3846. and is now Owned and Occupied by Dan^l Robins in right of said Jas Wilson. It also is included in a Survey made for Peter Miller by virtue of his order dated May 17th 1769. N^o 3240. The black lines represents the Peter Miller Survey in part & the dotted lines Jas Wilson. The Peter Miller is Owned & occupied by M^{rs} Nourse in right of said Peter Miller.
