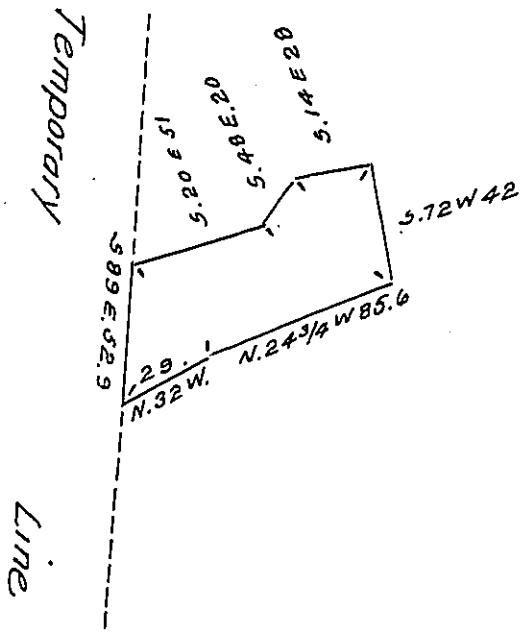

Warrant dated 28th Decem^r 1744 - to Hugh Whiteford for 25^{ac} on the Temporary Line.

In pursuance of the Several Acts of Assembly directing the Recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes. I have this day located & surveyed Warrant granted 28th Decem^r 1744 - to Hugh Whiteford for 25^{ac} on the Temporary line, on Lands situate as afore said, in Liberty Township Adams County, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
