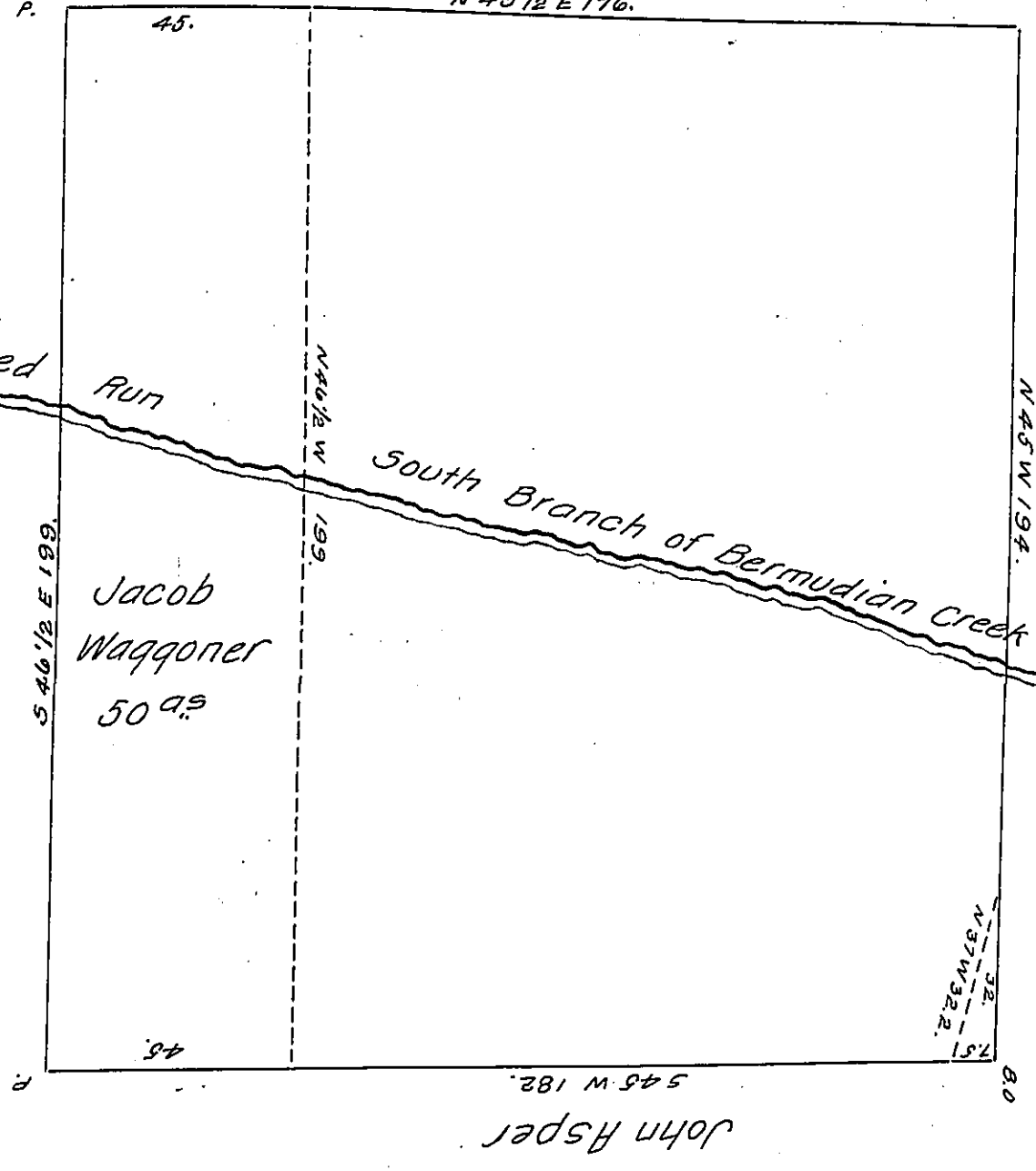

Warrant granted 6th October 1746 - to Jacob Waggoner for 50^{as} Joining Martin Wybrecht on the South Branch of Bermudian Creek.

The whole of the above Tract is an Interference of a Tract of 201⁹ 80^{ps} & all^{ce} surveyed to Lawrence Haan on two Warrants dated 21st February 1738, and 7th October 1740 - Situate formerly in Reading, now Washington Township York County now owned by John Raffensberger - Witness my hand.

November 8th 1838. Jn^o L. Gubernator —

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of December 1908.
