The above is a draft of the land described in the Order of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 2841 in the name of And<sup>w</sup> Linn of 3<sup>d</sup> Ap<sup>l</sup> 1769. it appears that the order was never executed for A. Linn, but was Surveyed to Nathan and then returned upon his Location, the land is now owned by Andrew Lynn Esq on the premises in Washington township.
