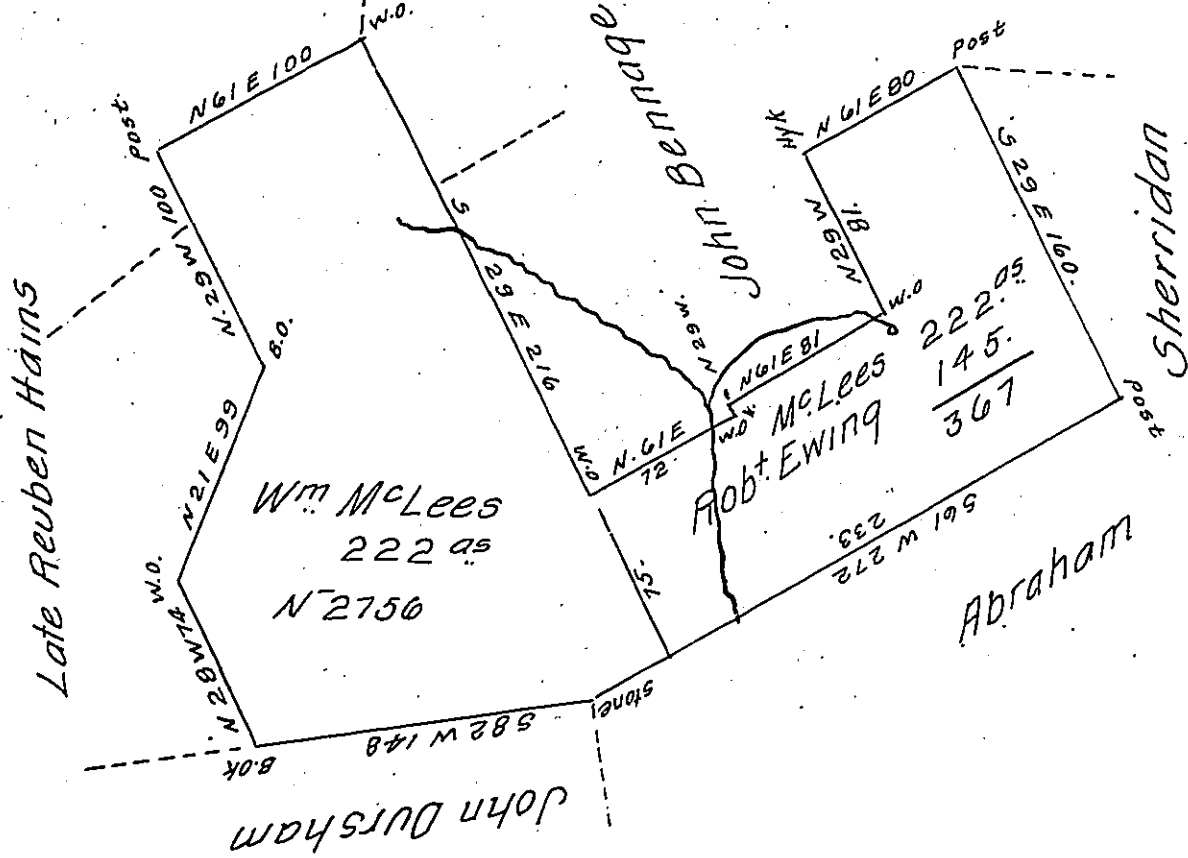


Joseph Vanqundy
