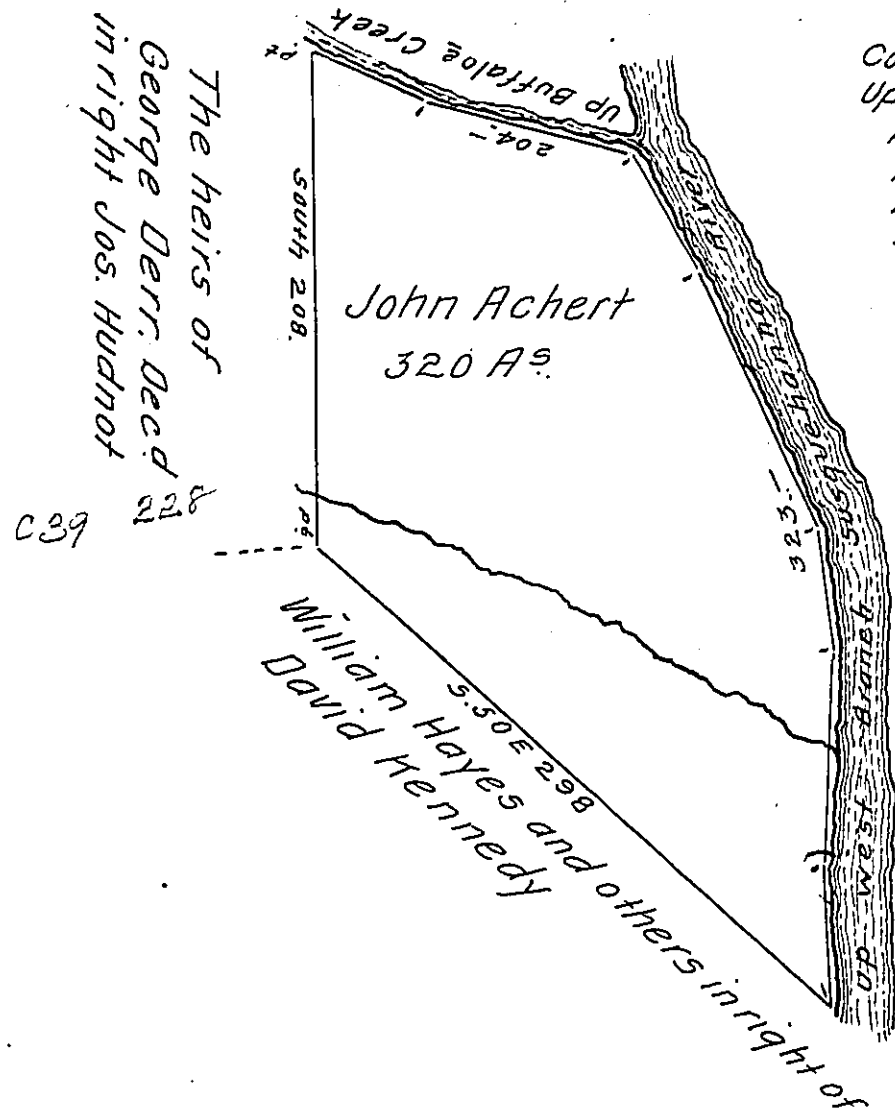

Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order granted to John Achert dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2721. Containing three hundred & twenty Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent &c.

The same was Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> February 1769 for Richard Peters by virtue of a Patent granted to Richard Peters dated the 11<sup>th</sup> of August A.D. 1772. for 320 Acres - The town of Lewisburg a part of the above described tract of land, the Residue is Divided into Lots and held by several persons in right of Richard Peters.
