



Situate in Kelly township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 7th day of March 1833 by virtue of an Order granted to David Mc. Murtrie dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 2730. Containing two hundred and fifty two Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 3^d day of October 1770 for Barnabas Parson in pursuance of his Order dated the 28th day of August 1769. N^o 3786. And now owned & occupied by Thomas Idding and Jacob Hartman in right of the said Barnabas Parson.
