



Situate in Buffaloe township Union County. Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1834 for George Chapman by virtue of his order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2742. Containing two hundred & seventeen Acres with the usual allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day of June 1771 for Catherine Rees in pursuance of her order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2518. and now owned & occupied by Robert Lowry & others in right of the said Catherine Rees.
