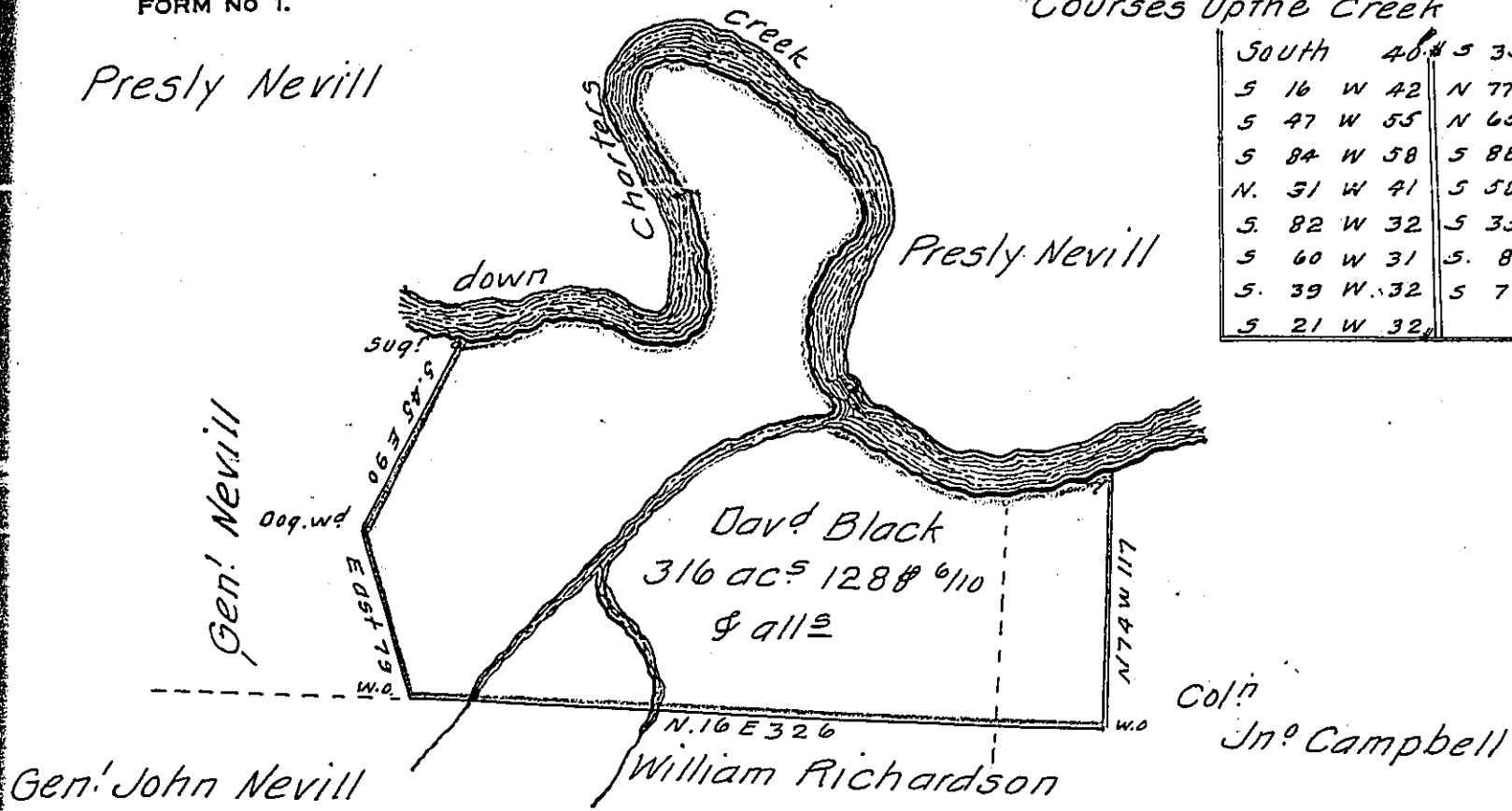

Pursuant to a Contract with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of penn<sup>a</sup> dated the first of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1827. & the authority therein, the above Tract of Land was Survey<sup>d</sup> and Calculated by Virtue of Ord<sup>r</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 3777. granted by the proprietary government to David Black 26<sup>th</sup> of August 1769. Containing three three Hundred Sixteen acres. one hundred twenty eight perches <sup>6</sup>/<sub>10</sub> & all<sup>s</sup>. Situate in St. Clair Township Allegheny County.

Note. this is the same Tract of Land Survey<sup>d</sup> to W<sup>m</sup> Lea. Feb<sup>r</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> 1787. on a Virginia Entry in name of S<sup>d</sup> Lea for 400 acres, the Heirs of Lea is in possession of the premises
