I hereby Certifie into ye Secretarys Office that I have caused to be Surveyed unto Greffeth Jones in ye behalfe of Tho Barker and Comp^a (Purchas^{rs} of five thousand Acres) ye 24th of ye said 12th M^o 1684. A Certain peece or parcil of Land (being part of their said Purchase) Seituare Lying and being in ye County of Chest^r. Begining at a Corn^r marked red oak. belonging to Tho. Brasseys Land from thence North North West by Ja^s Claypooles Land Six hundred and fourty perches to a Corn^r marked white oak from thence west south west by a line of marked trees five hundred perches to a Corn^r marked red oak from thence South South East by Sam^l Leav^s Land Six hundred and fourty perches. thence East North East by ye afore mentioned Brasseys Land five hundred perches. to ye first mentioned place of begining. Containig and Laid out for two Thousand acres of Land. And is accordingly Entred and Recorded in my Office at Philadelphia ye 26th of ye 2^d M^o 1687.
