



Situate in Chapman township Union County Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1835  
in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Lewis Dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of December 1774  
Containing Ninety four Acres and seventy eight perches & the Usual allowance &c & is  
designated by the Green lines

Note. - The same tract of land was surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 1775 for Jacob  
Armbrister in pursuance of two Warrants one dated the 6<sup>th</sup> of August  
1773 the other dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of December 1774 & now Occupied  
by Jacob Houser without title & is Designated by the Yellow lines.
