



Situate in Hartleton township Union County Surveyed the 18th day of December 1773 by William Maclay then Deputy Surveyor for Mordecai Lincoln in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 7th day of August 1773 Containing One hundred & fifty six acres & one hundred & thirty eight perches with the usual allowance of Six per Cent &c. Resurveyed the 8th day of November 1832 and found correct. ~

Note ~ The same tract of land was Surveyed on the 10th day of December 1816 for John Kleckner in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 9th day of December 1815 including more land ~ And now occupied by George Kleckner. ~
