


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Kelly township Union County Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November  
1832 by virtue of a Warrant granted to James Maglaughlin dated the 23<sup>d</sup> day of Febr-  
uary 1773 Containing three hundred and Nine Acres & 84 perches with the usual allowance &c.

Note. ~ The same tract of land was Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1773 for John  
Lukens in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of December  
1772 And now Owned by Joseph Kelly David Kelly and Andrew Kelly  
in right of the said John Lukens. ~
