Note. - The same survey interferes with a survey made for John Hayes and Anthony Carner the 20th day of April 1811 in pursuance of their Warrant dated the 4th day of June 1801 Containing One hundred and twenty six Acres. And now owned and occupied by in right of the said Hayes & Carner
