



Situate in Washington township Union County Surveyed the 29th day of July A.D. 1835 in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 22^d day of December 1773 Granted to Daniel Seiper Containing Seventy nine Acres & forty perches with the usual allowance of 6 per Cent & c. And was surveyed by William Maclay D.S. the 26th day of March 1774. ~
