 Surveyed the 2^d day of June 1774 for Phillip Cole in pursuance of his Warrant dated
 the 22^d day of November 1773. Containing fifty nine Acres & two tenths with the
 Usual allowance of Six $\frac{7}{8}$ Cent & c. Resurveyed the 1st day of August 1833 Accord-
 ing with the Original lines and found the Survey & c. Correct.

Note. On the 1st day of July 1786 a Warrant was granted to Thomas
 Hartley Esq a Survey was made in pursuance thereof which
 included the tract of land above described, the same is
 now owned and occupied by Daniel Spiegelmyer in right of
 the said Thomas Hartley
