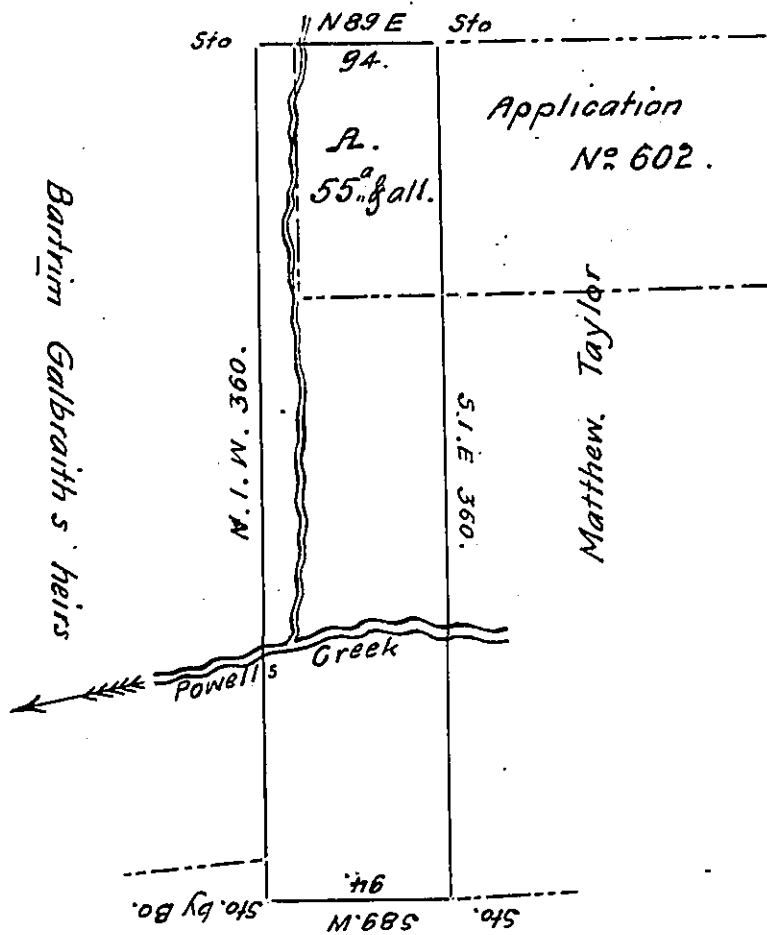


Dividing Ridge
